It covers the AgilePM[®] certification by APMG and the DSDM Consortium that has been created to sit alongside PRINCE2[®] as an approach to project management. The course is equally divided between the theory of the new wave of agile project management and the practical experience of the techniques and disciplines involved.

The AgilePM® Practitioner exam is taken at the end of the course and is a 2.5 hour, open book (AgilePM® Handbook v2 only) objective type exam format with 4 questions. There are 20 marks per question and the required pass mark is 50% (40/80).

Please therefore remember to bring your Handbook/Manual with you for the course and the open book practitioner exam.
